

EMERGENCY RESPONSE ON NEPAL FLOOD & LANDSLIDE

CONTEXT

26-28 September heavy rain caused widespread flooding, inundations, and landslides across Nepal.

Casualties: 250 dead, 178 injured, 18 missing

Damaged Homes: 5,916 fully destroyed, 12,477 partially damaged and 10,807 displaced households.

Impact:

- NPR 10 billion loss (Agriculture & livelihood sector)
- NPR 3 billion loss (26 hydropower: 1,636.1 MW)
- NPR 1.35 billion loss (7 irrigation projects)
- NPR 1.04 billion loss (146 bridges)
- NPR 151.8 million loss (Telecommunications)
- 260 education sector and 52 health sector affected

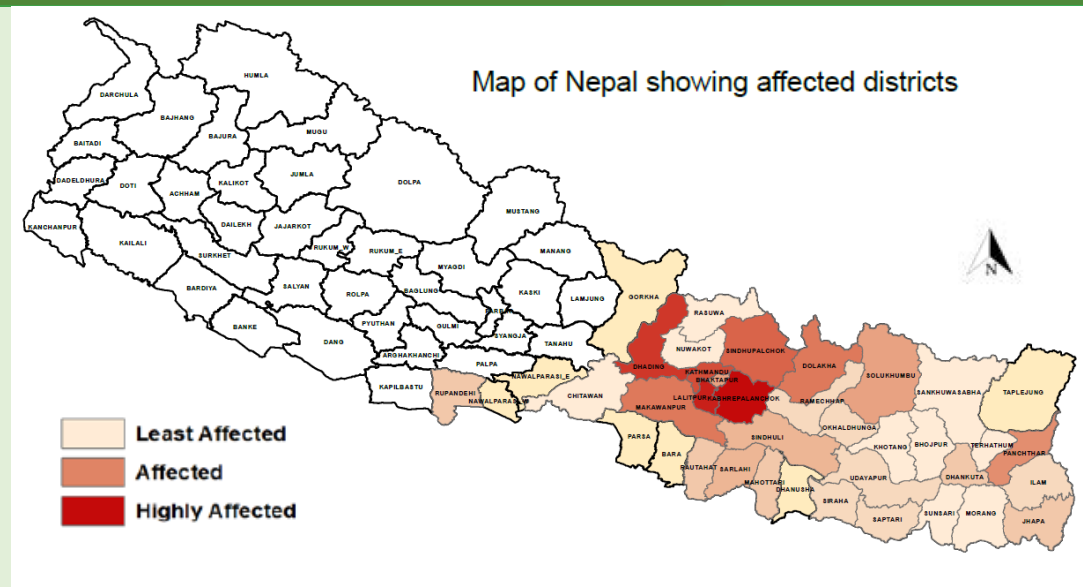

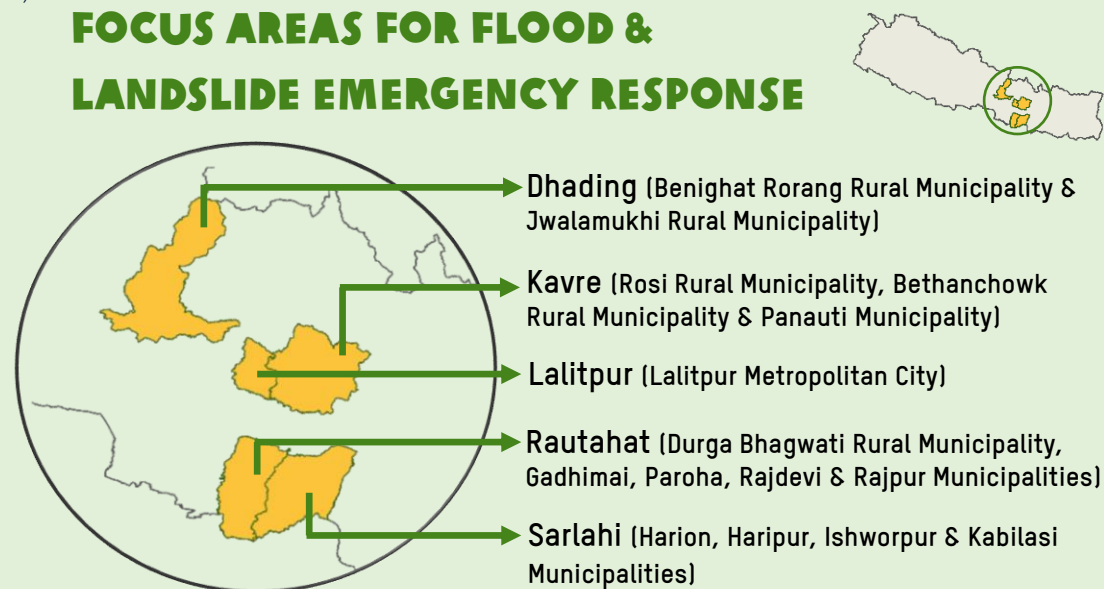

WATER, SANITATION AND HYGIENE



417 sets of Hygiene Kit

Distributed 64 hygiene kit in Sarlahi, 100 in Rautahat and 253 kit in Kavrepalanchok district.



1000 Piyush

Distributed 60ml of 1000 piyush in Kavrepalanchok district.



126 sets of Bucket & Mugs

Distributed 10ltr of 64 buckets with mugs in Sarlahi and 62 in Kavrepalanchok district.



9 Water Supply Scheme

Supported for repair and maintenance of 7 water supply schemes in Benighat Rorang Board and 2 water supply schemes in Jwalamukhi Board of Dhading district.



861 pcs. of GI Fittings

Supported 625 pcs of GI fittings in Benighat Rorang Board and 236 pcs in Jwalamukhi Board of Dhading district.

164 Ready to Eat (RTE) Food

Distributed 64 set of RTE food in Sarlahi and 100 in Rautahat district.



74 sets of Kitchen Utensils

85 Tarpaulin/Shelter Kit

Distributed 35 tarpaulin in Sarlahi and 50 shelter kit in Rautahat district.
